### **Optional Pre-Tour to Turin and Florence:**

#### **Day 1, Sun, May 11: Depart USA for Turin**

#### **Day 2, Mon, May 12: Turin Airport – Turin**

- Upon arrival check into hotel
- Group Meet and Great and proceed to celebrate Mass
- The Shroud of Turin (Shroud display is pending official Vatican confirmation)
- Welcome dinner and overnight in Turin

#### **Day 3, Tue, May 13: Turin**

- Breakfast
- Cathedral of St. John the Baptist
- Sanctuary of Maria Ausiliatrice (the Basilica of Our Lady Help of Christians)
- Corpus Domini Basilica
- Dinner and overnight

#### **Day 4, Wed, May 14: Turin – Milan – Turin**

- Breakfast
- Transfer to Milan for full day visit
- Portinari Chapel in the Basilica of Sant' Eustorgio and visit the tomb of St. Peter Martyr
- Duomo Cathedral of Milan
- St. Charles Borromeo and St. Ambrose
- Marvel at the famous "Last Supper" painting by Leonardo da Vinci, housed in the refectory of the Convent of Santa Maria delle Grazie (pending availability)
- Return to Turin for dinner and overnight

- Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel
- Catacombs
- Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls
- Dinner

#### **Day 4, Sun, May 18: Rome – Manoppello – Lanciano – San Giovanni Rotondo**

- Breakfast
- Leave Rome for Manoppello
- Venerate the Holy Face of Manoppello
- Leave Manoppello for Lanciano
- Venerate the Eucharistic miracle of Lanciano
- Mass
- Continue to San Giovanni Rotondo
- Dinner and overnight

#### **Day 5, Mon, May 19: San Giovanni Rotondo – Monte Sant Angelo – San Giovanni Rotondo**

- Breakfast
- Visit Old Church of Our Lady of Grace
- Board the bus and travel along the beautiful Gargano Peninsula to the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel
- Sanctuary of Monte Sant'Angelo
- Return to San Giovanni Rotondo for dinner and overnight

#### **Day 6, Tue, May 20: San Giovanni Rotondo – Montecassino – Rome**

- Breakfast
- Transfer to Abbey of Monte Cassino, the principal monastery of the Benedictine Order, founded by St. Benedict around 530 A.D
- Mass
- Continue to Rome for dinner and overnight
- Rosary (Optional)

#### **Day 7, Wed, May 21 Rome:**

- Breakfast
- Papal Audience
- Castle San Angelo
- Basilica of St. John the Lateran
- Mass
- Holy Stairs
- Basilica of Santa Croce
- Dinner and overnight

#### **Day 8, Thu, May 22 Rome – Rome Airport**

- Breakfast
- Transfer to the airport

### **Optional Post-Tour to Assisi:**

#### **Day 8, Thu, May 22 Rome - Orvieto – Assisi**

- Breakfast
- Transfer from Rome to Orvieto
- Visit Orvieto Church and celebrate Mass
- Continue to Assisi for dinner and overnight

#### **Day 9, Fri, May 23: Assisi. Full Day Tour**

- Breakfast
- Start tour at the St. Francis Basilica
- Visit his tomb of St. Francis
- Visit the Santuario Della Spogliazione where Blessed Carlo Acutis' tomb is placed
- Continue on a walking tour through this picturesque town
- Visit the birthplace of St. Francis and end with a tour of the Church that honors St. Clare, the foundress of the Poor Clare Sisters
- After lunch take a bus outside of the walls of Assisi, to the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels
- Dinner and overnight

#### **Day 10, Sat, May 24: Assisi - Loretto – Assisi**

- Breakfast
- Day trip to Loretto
- Visit the Holy House of Loreto
- Mass
- Free time for prayer and reflection
- Return to Assisi for dinner and overnight

#### **Day 11, Sun, May 25: Assisi- Gubbio – La Verna**

- Breakfast
- Drive through the beautiful Umbrian mountains to Gubbio.
- Enjoy this medieval town with a visit to St. Francis Church to celebrate Mass.
- Continue to La Verna, the place where St. Francis, over the years, had been seven times, the last time in 1224 where he received the stigmata.
- Pray in the Chapel of the Stigmata, the Basilica, and the Chapel of Saint Mary of the Angels.
- Return to Assisi for dinner and your last overnight.

#### **Day 12, Mon, May 26: Assisi – Rome Airport – USA**
